

## NATIONAL PET WEEK POSTER CONTEST 2025

### CONTEST GUIDELINES

**POSTMARK DEADLINE: June 1, 2024**

The Auxiliary to the American Veterinary Medical Association (Auxiliary to the AVMA) is pleased to announce its annual artistic poster contest. This contest will be for the 2025 National Pet Week theme, "**Caring People Care for Animals.**"

The poster contest is open to students in grades Kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

The poster should:

- Be the artist's original work.
- Be previously unpublished.
- Center around the NPW theme
- Must include the NPW theme in the body of the poster (Note: Make sure to include the exact words from the theme.)
- Be colorful.
- Be reproducible poster quality.
- Be either portrait or landscape in layout.
- Be **11 inches by 17 inches in size** (Note: paper may be any appropriate type for the artist's media but must be this size.)
- Be accompanied by an entry form that has all pertinent information filled in.
- Media may be the artist's choice. Art can represent the following mediums: drawing and painting (i.e., pencil, charcoal, pastels, colored pencils, marker, crayon, oil paints, acrylics, water media, mixed media/collage) and original digital creations.
- Digital artwork will now be accepted but must be 11x17 when printed. Digital artwork must be submitted in .jpg or .png format.
